Tim Stafford is Director of Operations of the Vanderbilt Kennedy Center, a position he has held since 2003. He manages the nonscientific aspects of the Center and oversees personnel. He facilitates access to the Center's research support services and family and community outreach programs.

Before joining the Vanderbilt Kennedy Center, Mr. Stafford was Assistant Executive Director of Medical Center Development, where he prepared and monitored the budget, provided strategic support to executive staff, managed information systems, and managed administrative support staff. He joined the staff of Vanderbilt Medical Center in 1996.

Mr. Stafford served on the BSR Product Advisory Group, a 10-member national advisory group drawn from users of BSR Advance alumni and development software application. He has been a member of the Vanderbilt University Campus Technology Forum. He is an alumnus of Vanderbilt University Leadership Development Forum (250 alumni from among 10,000 employees). He is a member of the Council for Advancement and Support of Education (CASE).
